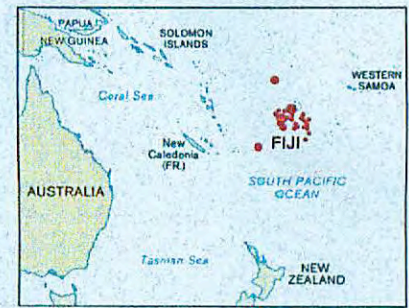




The Gray Family Missionaries to the Fiji Islands

Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

Greetings from the Grays, your missionaries to the people of the Fiji Islands. We have now been on furlough in the USA since March, and we are enjoying the time we have spent visiting family, friends, and our supporting churches. God blessed us with excellent meetings in churches in Ohio and Pennsylvania during the months of June and July. We have now returned to Alaska and will be visiting churches in the state till the end of the year. The Lord gave us safe travels as we covered about 15,000 miles in two months without even so much as a flat tire!

Proverbs 25:25 says, "As cold waters to a thirsty soul, so is good news from a far country." We have heard good reports from Victory Baptist Church in Suva, Fiji, that the ministry is progressing well in our absence. The church is being overseen by a man named Bro. Aaron, who is from another Baptist church around the island. He is doing a fine job preaching, along with several of our own men who are teaching Sunday school and leading in various ministries. Souls are being saved and the members are being faithful, and we are so happy to hear these good reports. This is a portion of a letter that Bro. Aaron recently sent to me:

"Pastor Ryan, I am really thankful to the Lord for the opportunity to serve here at Victory Baptist Church. I am facing some new experiences and challenges. I am thankful for the support I'm getting from the men of the church. Brother Mo preached a good message on Wednesday night on being a good ambassador for Christ. We had a wonderful time.

We have planned to go out together once a month with our ladies at 2 pm during our visitation and soul winning. Before we go out I will be teaching a soul winning course to help our visitation team on how to approach people, give their testimony and how to be effective. We want to do this on every last week of the month.

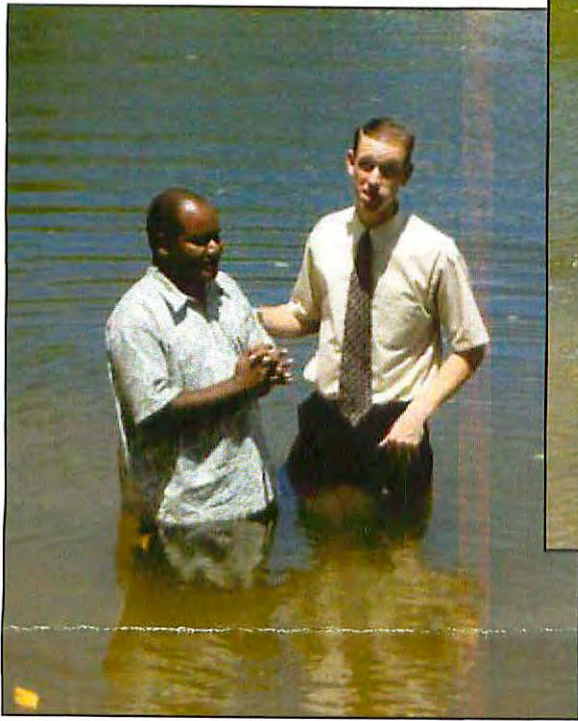
This week on Thursday, we went to the hospital, and we led a boy named Peni to the Lord. He is going to come this Sunday to church."

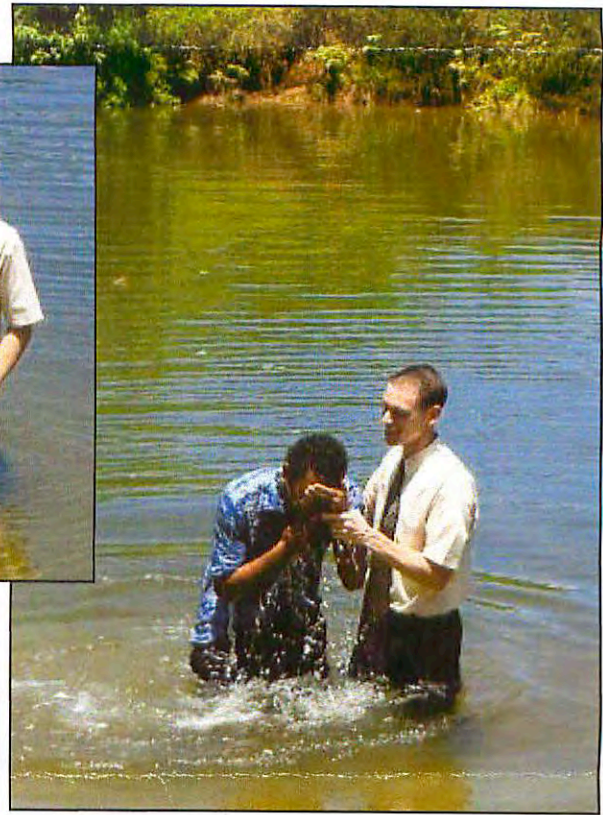
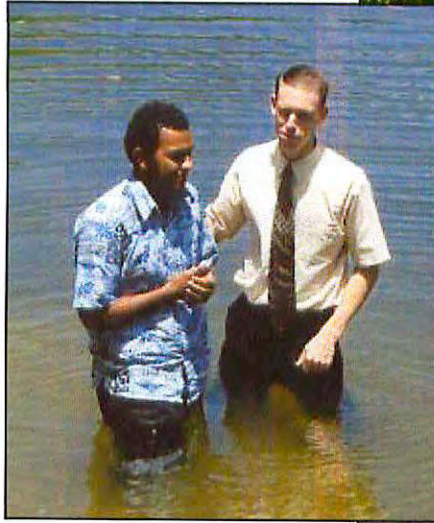

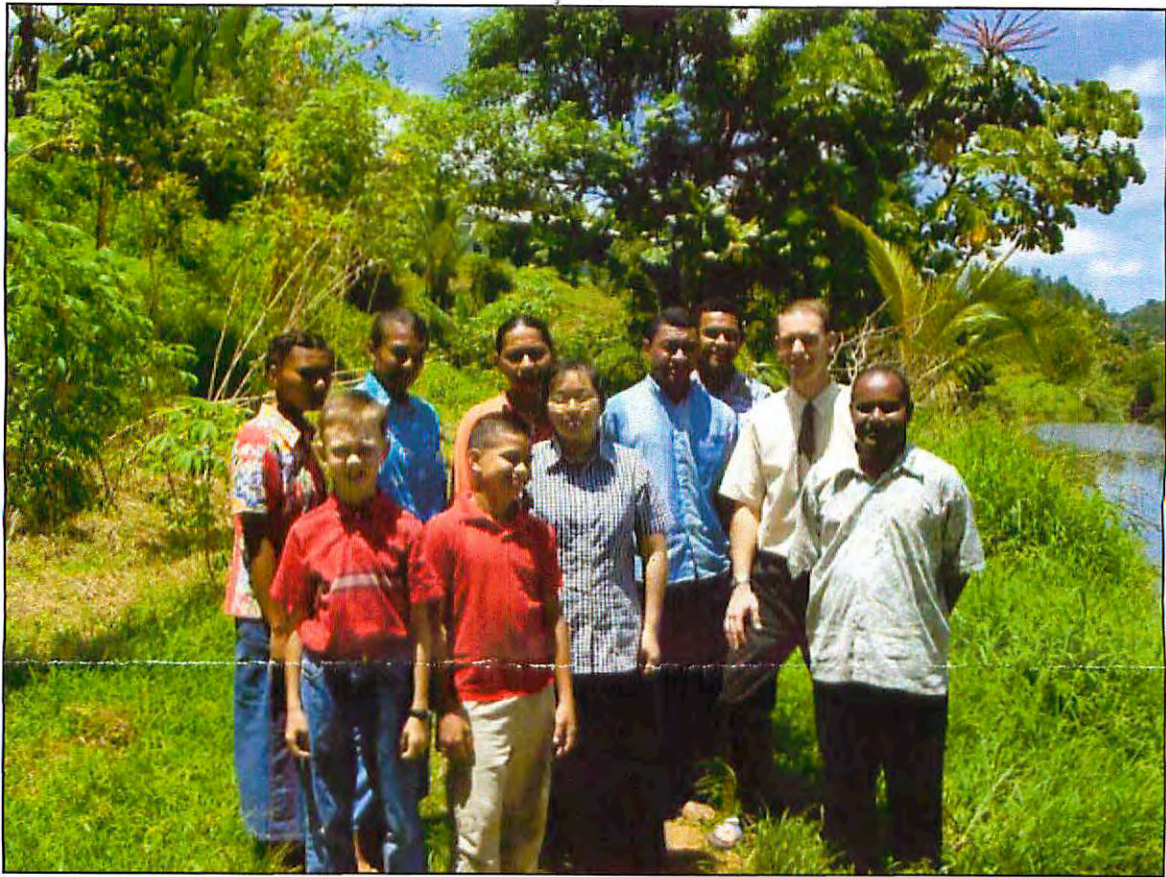


Bro. Morris Namoga of the Solomon Islands following the Lord in believer's baptism.
